

Q. What was the Colossus of Rhodes?

H. E. R. A. The Colossus of Rhodes, one of the wonders of the ancient world, was a brass statue of the Greek sun god Apollo about 100 feet high. It was erected by Chares of Lindus at the port of Rhodes. It took 12 years to build, cost over \$258,000 and was overturned by an earthquake in 224 B. C.

Q. When did bishops first begin to wear distinguishing rings?

O. M. The earliest known use of a bishop's ring is traced to Calixtus, bishop of Rome from A. D. 283 to 296. In the earliest references to rings worn by bishops there is nothing to distinguish them from other signet rings and not until 610 is mention found of the episcopal ring as a symbol of dignity.

Under the point-count system, you must have a minimum count of 13 points in order to open the bidding. To make a game at three no trump or four of a major suit, the two hands in the partnership must total at least 26 points.

Today's hand is an illustration. North and South arrive at three no trump because South, who has 13 points and North has 14 points. When South bids one heart, North bids two clubs. South signs off with two hearts to show that he has a minimum, but that he does not have a rebiddable heart suit.

Four no trump is made as declarer loses only two spades and point-count, North now might bid two no trump, in which case South should pass, and that is where the hand would be played.
