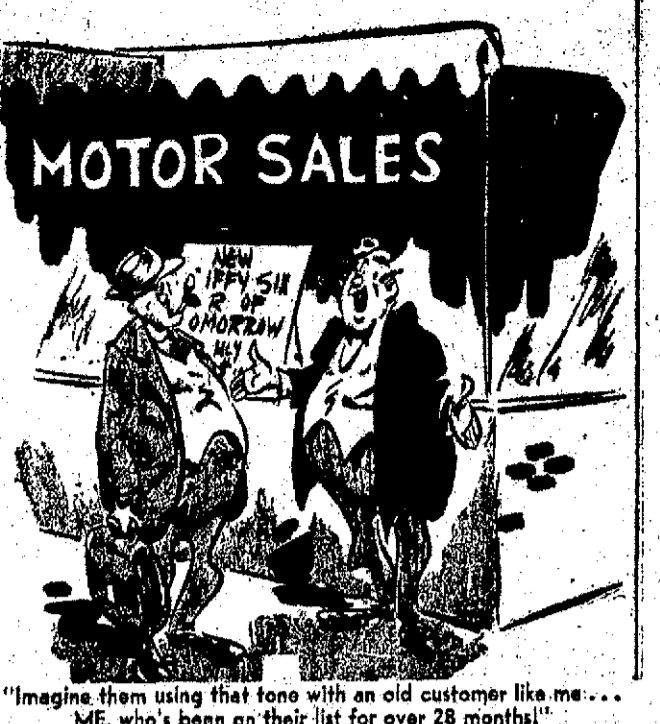

Q. What was the Colossus of Rhodes?

H. E. R. A. The Colossus of Rhodes, one of the wonders of the ancient world, was a brass statue of the Greek sun god Apollo about 100 feet high. It was erected by Chares of Lindus at the port of Rhodes. It took 12 years to build, cost over \$258,000 and was overturned by an earthquake in 224 B. C.

Q. When did bishops first begin to wear distinguishing rings?

O. M. The earliest known use of a bishop's ring is traced to Calixtus, bishop of Rome from A. D. 283 to 296. In the earliest references to rings worn by bishops there is nothing to distinguish them from other signet rings and not until 610 is mention found of the episcopal ring as a symbol of dignity.
