Q. Please distinguish between joint resolution of Congress and a concurrent resolution. A.

A. A joint resolution is the work of both houses and requires the approval of the Presi-cent (except in cases where it is used to submit proposed consti-tutional amendments for ratification) and has the force of law just as other legislation. In fact, joint resolutions are num-bered as Public Law No. ----- in - in the Statutes at Large. A con-current resolution requires the approval of both houses, but not of the President unless it contains matters of legislation. It is not public law, but deals with matters over which the two houses have concurrent jurisdiction.

Q Are the Pribilof Islands off the southwestern coast of Alaska the only land areas inhabited by fur seals? J. D. L. A. According to a report of the Fish and Wildlife Service these islands are thought to be the only land the fur seals touch. They have been a furseal reserve of the United States since 1868.



By WILLAM E. MORENNEY This is the third of a series of articles, based on Fred L. Karpin's booklet, "The Point-Count System of Bidding in Contract Bridge.

It has been difficult save Mr. Karpin; to interpret the precise significance of jump bids, but with the point count system, the true meaning of jump bids is no longer ambiguous.
