



Q. What is the most useful plant? W. P.

plant? W. P.

Ai This is a matter on which opinion differs. The coconut palm, aorghum, maize, sugar cane, peanut, soybean and bamboo have all been named. According to one authority there is not a category of human needs which cannot be supplied by some form of product of bamboo. Food, weapons, shelter, implements, ciothes, baskets and containers, bridges, pipes, paper, cable, ornaments are some of the uses to which it is put.

Q. What is the origin of Dog Days? F. G.

A. This hot spell in July and August was attributed in early days to the influence of the Dog Star (Sirius). In early July the sun was then almost due north of Sirius, and the old belief was that the combined hoat of the brightest star and the sun produced the high temperatures generally experienced at this time of the year.

Q. Are oysters valuable as food? J. D.

A. Oysters are a good source of the vitamin B complex, containing both riboflavin and thiamin. They contain also vitamins A, C and D and sea saits, mainly iodine. It has been calculated that a year's harvest of oysters in the United States has a food value equivalent to 400,000 dressed steers.

Q. How many people of the United States live in localities where the sale of liquor is prohibited? C. M. F.

A. Recent estimates by state liquor officials show that between 26 and 26½ million persons live in areas that are legally "dry." This figure represents nearly one-fifth of the total population.

Q. How is it that 2, 4-D kills the weeds in a lawn without harming the grass? E. F. F. A. The weed killer, 2, 4-D is a hormone that is particularly destructive to broad-leaved plants because they absorb it more readily than the narrow-leaved ones. Thus it allows for selective action which is destructive to the weeds without harming the the weeds without harm siender blades of grass.






