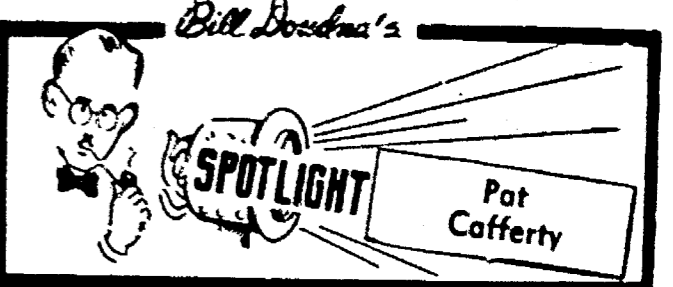

Pat Cafferty, young Madison actress, is back at home after a season of summer stock. She was a member of the National Theater Group of Chicago, which played a full season at Pine Point theater, Elkhardt Lake.

Pat is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Cafferty, North Shore bay. She has lived in Madison four years. She attended Edgewood college and appeared in plays there; notably as Malvolio in "Twelfth Night." Deciding on the stage as a career, she went to Chicago and enrolled in the Goodman Theater school.

Last year, she was back in Madison, teaching in elementary schools.

During the 1948 season, she appeared in "Arsenic and Old Lace," "Candle Light," "Angel Street," "The Great Big Doorstep," "Three-Cornered Moon," "On Approval," and "Guest in the House."

At season's end, the whole company came to Madison for a weekend at the Cafferty home before separating.

Among the actors were Irwin Charone, formerly of the Bieffy Players; Gilbert Shine, formerly of the Delavan Footlight Players; Shirley Daniels, Ripon, and once a University of Wisconsin student, and Millard Mack, LaCrosse native.

RADIO: A last-minute shuffle of NBC's Tuesday lineup will add "Big Town" to the schedule, with Bob Hope's show moving to an earlier spot than last season. "Big Town" will be on the air at 8 and 9 p. m. and Hope at 7 and 8 p. m., beginning Sept. 14.

The same network's "Radio City Playhouse" will move to Saturdays beginning this week. It has been heard Mondays.
