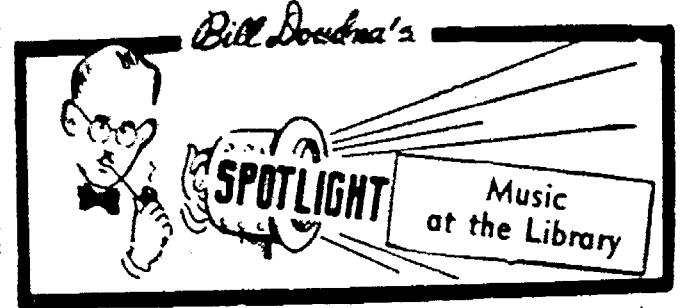

Every week is Music Week at the Madison Free Library, where the city's music-lovers find records, scores, librettos, and books about music. Lillian Moehlman, head of the library has more than 1,000 bound volumes of music, in addition to the other material. These scores are for violin, organ, piano, voice, and string ensembles.

During the opera season, there is a steady demand for librettos and stories of those broadcast Saturday afternoons. And the record-lending service, which was started Feb. 1, has a steadily growing list of subscribers. Seekers after biographical material on composers will find such standard works as "Groves Dictionary of Music and Musicians" and the "International Encyclopedia of Music and Musicians," as well as such works as "Composers in America," "Book of Modern Composers," and others.

For beginning listeners there are such volumes as "Relax and Listen: How to Enjoy Music Through Records" and five of Dr. Sigmund Spaeth's books. The experienced concert-goer will discover such things as Abraham's "Beethoven's Second-Period Quartets" and Fuller-Maitland's "Schumann's Concerted Chamber Music."
