

Mrs. Frederick said that the final contract is seven spades, with South the declarer, and West opens the king of clubs. Before reading my solution, I suggest that you lay the cards out and go to work on the problem yourself.

problem yourself. On the opening lead of the king of clubs you play the four of diamonds from dummy and win the trick in your hand with the acc. of clubs. You cannot try to cash the acc of hearts, or it will be ruffed, so you lead the deuce of spades and win it in dummy with the fack. Then trump the six of dia-monds with the three of spades.

and lead the five of spades, and lead the five of spades to dummy's queen. Trump the seven of spades, lead the ten and lead the five of spades to dummy's queen. Trump the your hand. Then cash the ace jack of diamonds with the of diamonds and discard the seven of spades, lead the ten king of hearts, of spades to dummy's king. Now you have picked up all cash the ace of spades, and of West's trumps, and all five discard the ace of hearts from of dummy's hearts are good.

A. Nicotine does not influence the flavor or aroma of tobacco to any important extent. It determines the strength of the tobacco.




