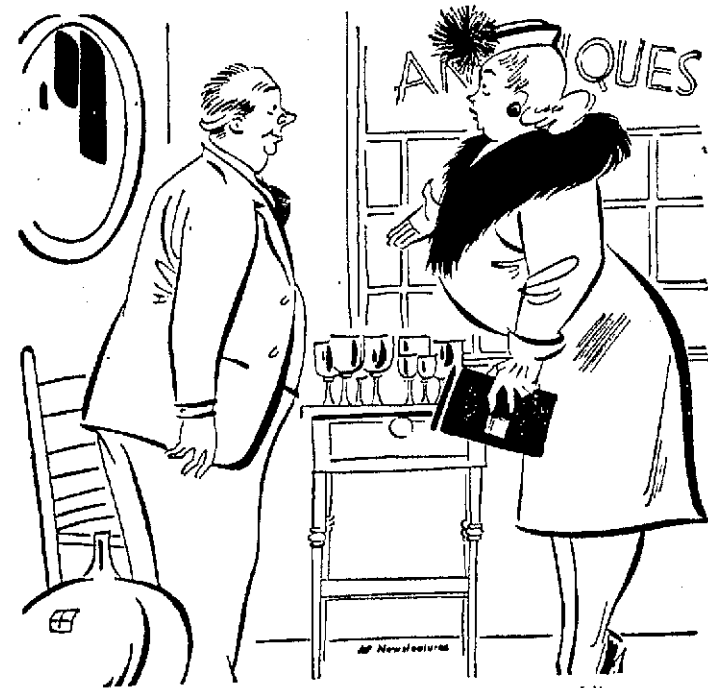

Checkoff Is Union Dues Deduction

Q. What is meant by the checkoff system? L. McC.
A. Under the checkoff system the employer agrees to deduct dues and assessments for the union from the workers' pay checks and turns the funds over to the union.

Q. What is the source of the quotation on the Arlington Amphitheater, "When we assumed the soldier, we did not lay aside the citizen"? O. P.
A. These were the words of George Washington, uttered to reassure the New York Provincial Congress in 1775 that he and his Army would act only to secure and preserve the liberties of the people.

Q. What was the fate of Gavrilu Prinzp, whose assassination of Archduke Francis of Austria precipitated the first World War? C. O. L.
A. Gavrilu Prinzp was sentenced to a term of 20 years in an Austrian prison because he was only 18 years old and too young, under Austrian law, for the death sentence. He died in a fortress near Prague on May 2, 1918.

Q. How fast does radium disintegrate? P. McC.
A. The rate at which radium breaks down is fairly constant and scientists believe that on average about one in 100 billion atoms of radium breaks up each second.

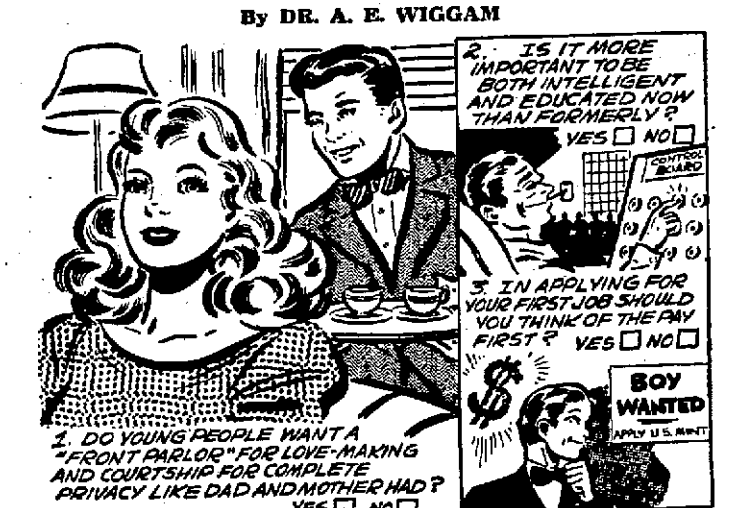
Q. Does the toy jug represent a real person? N. M.
A. The toy jug is said to be an effigy of Toby Philpot, a legendary bon vivant. Most of these jugs are in gay colors, the faces generally leering, but occasionally genial and smiling. It is said that the earliest one recorded by a European maker was made by Botcher in Saxony some time in 1708.

Q. Who was the first cardinal in the United States? E. K. K.
A. Bishop John McCloskey was named Cardinal by Pope Pius IX, the investiture taking place in Old St. Patrick's in New York City on April 27, 1875. Cardinal McCloskey died the present St. Patrick's Cathedral four years later.

Q. Do women own as much life insurance as men? G. I.
A. The Institute of Life Insurance reports that women own nearly \$40 billion in life insurance, or about 1.5 of all life insurance in force in the United States.

Q. Exactly how much longer is the equinoctial year than the calendar year? O. L. C.
A. An equinoctial year lasts 365 days, 5 hours, 48 minutes and 45.2 seconds. Since the calendar year is only 365 days long it is necessary to add an extra day every four years, known as leap year. This, however, makes these calendar years 11 minutes and 14 seconds too long in the century years except those divisible by 400.

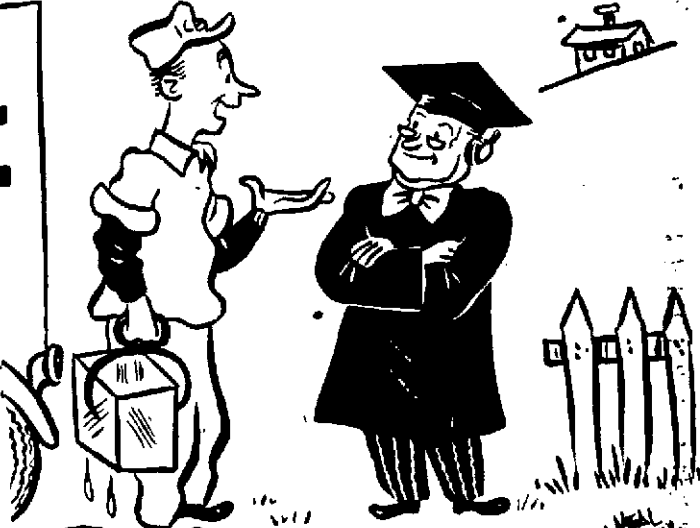
