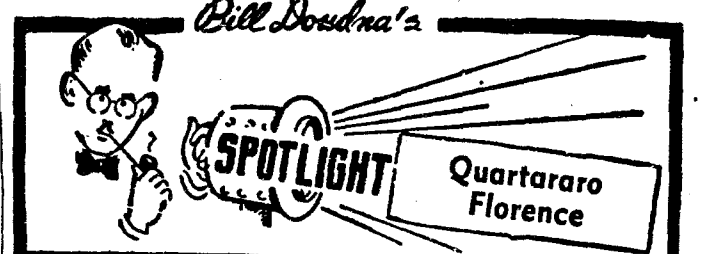

Its lack of body was most apparent in the songs of Brahms and Strauss, which Miss Quartararo nevertheless delivered with understanding and grace.

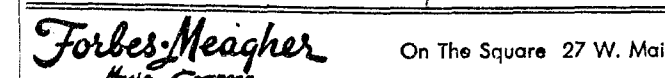

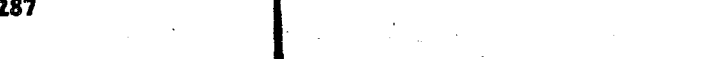

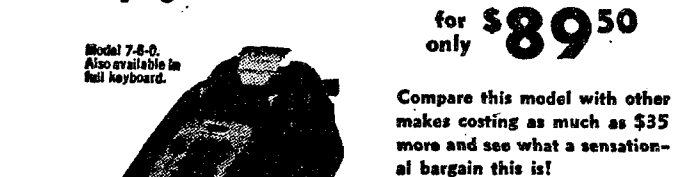
