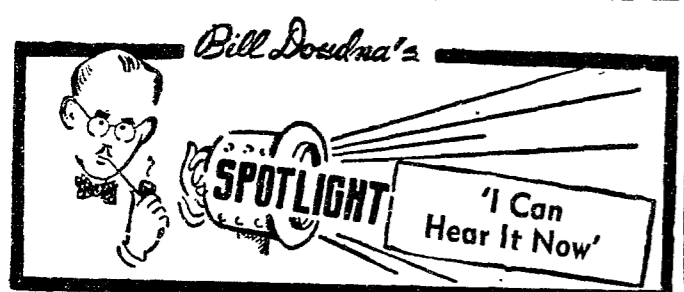


Joan Taliaferro Stars as 'Juggler' at U. W. Fete
