SPOTLIGHT
Paintings by Hodgell

Thirteen oils and water colors by Bob Hodgell, Madison, make up the second exhibit in a series by artists of Madison and vicinity on the walls of the Madison Bank and Trust Co. The first show was by Byron C. Jorns.

Hodgell was born in Kansas, came to Madison to study at the University of Wisconsin and became a special student of and assistant to the late John Steuart Curry, artist-in-residence. He worked on several of Curry's murals. Then, as a naval trainee, he worked with Paul Sample of Dartmouth. After active duty in the South Pacific, he returned to the university in 1946.

During the past year, Hodgell's paintings have won honorable mentions at the Missouri Valley Artists show, Topeka; the Western Artists exhibition, Denver, and a national show at the Indiana, Pa., State Teachers college. One of his linoleum blocks was chosen as one of last year's "prints of the year" and was shown in the Library of Congress, the Carnegie galleries, and elsewhere.

Hodgell received his master's degree in applied art last spring, and opened his own studio for full-time free-lance work. His most recent works have included a 4,700-square foot mural for the Wisconsin Centennial agriculture exhibit.
