



The University of Wisconsin Concert band Sunday ran the gamut from Bach to Berlin, and did right by both composers. It was the musicians' annual Palm Sunday concert, given in the Wisconsin Union theater for an audience of about

Emmett Sarig, acting director, had built a symphonic organiza-tion in the best sense of the word, one which played with unity and uniformity even when the rhyth-mic going was rough. Each group of instruments seemed to have a or instruments seemed to have a sense of responsibility for its own work and for the band as a whole, and the young men and women gave their director almost

flawless response Few major works have been written especially for band, and Sarig chose one of them to open the concert.

It was Fauchet's B-flat symphony, no great music in itself but an effective dmonstration of what can be done by a composer who sets out to write for this medium. Above all, he showed a sharp appreciation for the "feel" of the concert band, reflected in the careful choice of instruments for each passage.

The scherzo was particularly delightful—it had the joy of a mendelssohn, the lively approach to an instrumental problem that

to an instrumental problem that would have pleased Berlioz.

Gunnar Saevig, violinist, was soloist; this was unique, since the band never had had a violin soloist, and there is little, if any, music for this combination.




