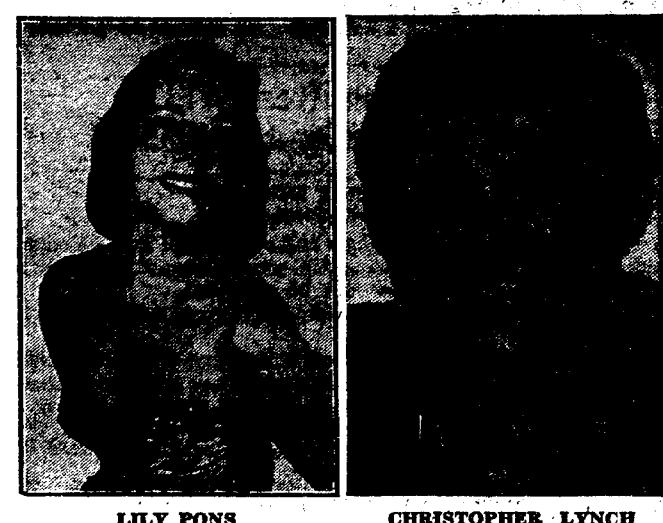

New Discovery Met With Reservations BOSTON (U.P.)—Seven of New England's top cancer authorities have cautioned against any overconfidence prompted by the discovery of a "reasonably sure" blood test for cancer. Commenting on the announcement by Dr. Charles Huggins of the University of Chicago of a "simple, cheap" test, the group said it still was "untried" and "too early" for public application.

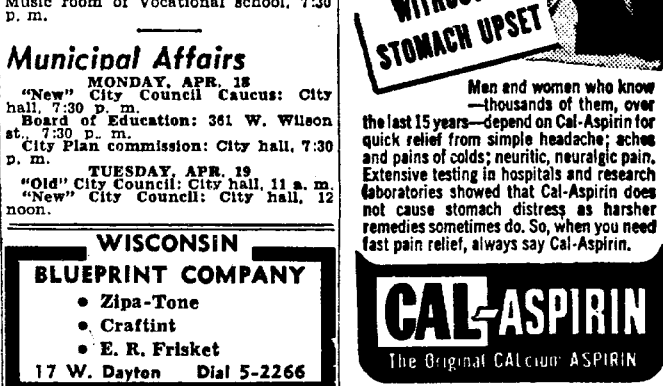
On the Campus
