Light Rays Influenced by Gravity By HASKIN

Q. WHAT IS the degree of hending of a light ray due to gravity?—A. L.

A. The National Bureau of Standards says that the most recent eclipse observations indicate that starlight on passing the edge of the sun is deflected by the sun's gravitational pull by an amount slightly in excess of two seconds of arc. Einstein's relativity theory predicts a deflection of 1% seconds.
