BARCLAY ON BRIDGE By Shepard Barclay

THE MAIN DIFFERENCE THE MORE you watch players of all grades, the more you will realize what is the most pronounced difference between the bidding of top-ranked and that of average or fair contestants. It is in their bidding of four-card suits, not only four-card majors, but four-card minors. The great merit in bidding the latter, when the suit has a probable No Trump stopper, is that showing it to your partner may be the key to a No Trump game contract. Bidding a major four-carder has the additional point that it might match a four-card length in the partner's hand, making a major game logical.
