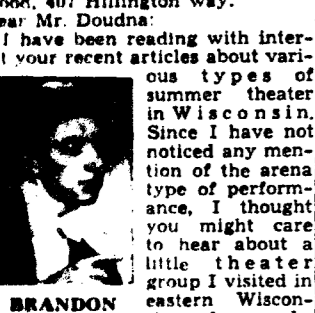


A letter from Mirabelle Netherland, 407 Hillington way:
