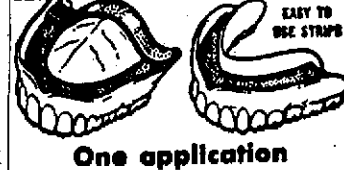
### Hall Heads Sauk City Industrial Foundation
