Excessive amounts of sugar and starch often interfere with normal functioning of the skin, so consequently aggravate acne. Rich fatty foods, greasy foods and fried foods also play a considerable part in the cause of skin blemishes.

The main factors involved in the correction of acne are diet, skin cleanliness and exercise. We'll start with diet. The one food that must be avoided altogether is chocolate That means candy, sauce, frosting, cakes, cookies, puddings, chocolate milk. cocoa, hot chocolate, chocolate ice cream --- all forms of chocolate must be strictly avoided.

Other fats to shun are gravy fried foods and the fatty part of meats. Go light on mayonnaise. French dressing, peanut butter and even butter and cream. Avoid all even butter and cream. Avoid an rich pastries and desserts, whipped cream and sauces on ice cream. Also stay away from hot breads and such things as dumplings with gravy.

Never mind if this cuts out your favorite foods — the results will be well worth it. You may as'. ruefully, what's left? All the proruefully, what's fett and the pro-tective foods, the foods around which a good weight-control diet is planned — milk, fresh and can-ned fruits, all vegetables, whole grain bread and cereal, lean meat, fish and fowl, eggs and cheese. You won't go hungry.

In some allergy cases the acno may be caused by a particular food sensitivity — to milk or eggs, for example — but these are the exception.

With others, the trouble may be traceable to a cosmetic allergy, including powder, face cream, nail polish, hand lotion, lipstick. Or the allergy may be to feathers, dust or something of that nature. A skin specialist, called a dermatologist. can make tests to find the offending substance. Be sure to ask hi fee first. There are now non-allergic cosmetics on the market.

Cleanliness is all important. Don't powder over a dirty face or use a soiled puff or rub face with dirt, hands. Wash your face several times a day with a mild soap, one that is low in fat. Rinse off all Avoid face creams that are soap. rich in fats. Particular attention should also be given the scalp and hair, for acne can start there.

Outdoor exercise stimulates cir culation and is imperative for healthy functioning of the skin. Join a hiking club, play badminton, tennis, skate, bike, rake leaves . any active outdoor exercise. Drink plenty of water between

meals. Have a large glass of warm water with juice of half a lemon before breakfast, and after breakfast allow time for regular elimination. Habit is a big factor in regu-
