Actress Prefers Video to Movie Role Because of Film Sex Emphasis

NEW YORK, Oct. 14. (UP) Hollywood's emphasis on sex is driving hopeful young actresses to seek a career in television, a young TV actress said today.

"They're coming to New York to be in television in preference to the movies, said lovely Kathleen O'Hara.

Miss O'Hara, a 22-year-old brunette, she turned down Hollywood contracts twice for television. The reasons, she said, were many.

First, and most important, she said, was "this matter of sex."

"In Hollywood," she said, "they over-emphasize sex so much that it frightens a girl. In television you've got to have it, it's true. But protocol doesn't demand that you over-emphasize it."

No all-night parties with executives whose wives don't understand them, she said. No wagers who promise a screen test and demand the key to the apartment in the same breath.

"And," she added, "there are no contract clauses that stipulate you must pose—in what is practically the altogether—for publicity pictures before you can get a 'break.'"

From a professional viewpoint, she said, television had it all over the movies for the aspiring actress.

Smart Play Made Contract on Dubious Spade Slam Bid

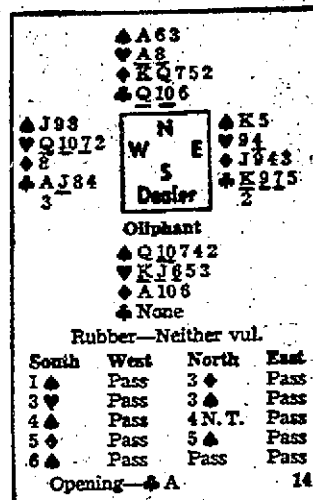

WHILE practically every city has a bridge club, it is surprising that there are not more bridge clubs. We all seek congenial companionship, and that is what bridge clubs provide. Of course a married couple can invite another couple in for an evening of bridge, but perhaps the husband and wife do not get along well as bridge partners. And what about the people who are alone? They can go to a bridge club, sit in a foursome and enjoy an evening of bridge.

Murray Oliphant likes to spend an evening at the Mayfair Bridge Club in New York City, after a heavy day at his plant, where he manufactures confirmation and graduation dresses. Today's hand came up in a rubber bridge game at the club. Oliphant sat South, and made an opening distributional bid of one spade. His partner made a jump shift bid of three diamonds, and they arrived at a rather doubtful slam—but Murray made it in the following manner.

He trumped the opening lead of the ace of clubs and led the four of spades to dummy's ace. A small spade was led from dummy and East won the trick with the king. East elected to return a diamond, which Murray won with the tenstop. The queen of spades picked up West's last trump, then



Murray proceeded to cash the balance of the diamonds, discarding two hearts from his own hand.

I have underlined the cards left in each hand at this point. Murray led the queen of clubs from dummy. If East had not covered, Murray would have discarded another heart. When East covered with the king of clubs, Murray trumped with the ten of spades, and discarded his losing heart on the good ten of clubs.

VIDEO BOON TO FACE-LIFTERS

Screen Image Must Lure Voters, Politicians Own

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 14. (UP) Many politicians, their facial defects magnified for the public gaze by newsreel and television closeups, have undergone oral surgery, according to the new president of the American Society of Oral Surgeons.

The rebuilding of the face has become popular with politicians, as it has actors, Dr. Berto A. Olson of Hollywood reported. Olson, in town for the three-day 31st annual convention of the association, will succeed Dr. James R. Cameron, Philadelphia.

Professional ethics prevented the two doctors from revealing names, but both agreed that "face-lifting" has become a

necessary part of gathering the popular vote.

"With newsreels and television, politicians found they were in the same boat with movie stars," Olson said. "Their faces are blown up to such size on the screen that every little defect shows up."

"Many politicians have undergone oral surgery because they found that people were taking a dislike to them on account of some peculiar expression brought on by mouth deformities."
