Expert Lists Karpin System's Seven Responses to Two Bid

SOMETIME ago I presented the Point-Count System of Bidding in Contract Bridge, as written by Fred L. Karpin, of Washington, D. C., in a new book.

There are seven different responses: 1. If you have an ace in any suit, bid that suit, regardless of whether the ace is a singleton or the top of a suit of any length.

2. If you have two kings, jump to three no trump. (a) With three kings, jump to three no trump, then bid four no trump on your rebid.

3. If you have two aces, jump to four no trump (a force to slam). 4. If you have an ace and two kings, bid the ace first, then jump to four no trump on your rebid (a force to slam).

5. If you have an ace-king in the same suit, make a jump bid in that suit. (a) With an ace of one suit, and the king of another suit, bid the ace first, then the king suit.

6. If you have an ace and no other aces, West now knows that a slam is in the hand and the only thing to be determined is the suit. That is found out in short order. If West did not know which ace East had, he might figure on two club losers.
