Sponsor to Pay \$150,000 for Thanksgiving Night Top Stars T-V Vaudeville

NEW YORK. (AP) It's going to cost an estimated \$150,000 to put on a special holiday television show the night of Thanksgiving. That includes the price of hooking up 25 or more NBC-TV network stations. The biggest part of the outlay, however, is going for talent, since on CBS, and last year switching the intention is to use such personalities as Milton Berle, George Jessel and the Ritz Brothers. The sponsor (Elgin) is making arrangements for an hour and a half production which already is labeled as the "costliest television show yet."
