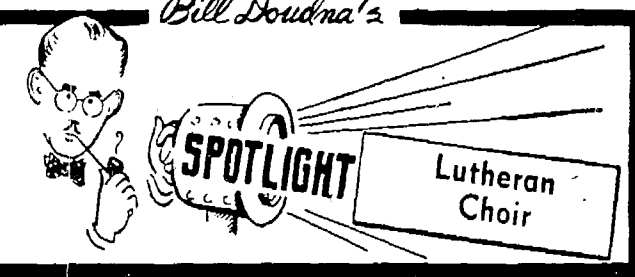

Gross is 51. He lived in Highland Park, Detroit, when he was arrested in 1933 for the slaying of a rug peddler. A year after his imprisonment, Gross and his wife were divorced at his request. His last word of her came from Paterson, N. J.
