Eunice Kaplan shared the honors as the mother of the Bronx family, fighting every inch for that family and for herself only as a part of it.

Charles Levy drew a convincing picture of a weak and unloved husband, and Charles Mark one of a fading grandfather, whose failure had given him wisdom and strength. Sherwin Abrams was excellent as a coniving uncle.
