**DIMITRI MITROPOULOS, DISTINGUISHED GREEK CONDUCTOR, TAKES OVER THE** podium of the New York Philharmonic-Symphony in his first broadcast of the season, heard over KTSA 2:00-3:30 p.m. (FM) and 10:30 p.m. to 12:00 midn. (AM). Mr. Mitropoulos will be heard as conductor and piano soloist, playing and directing the first American broadcast of Ernst Krenek's Concerto No. 3 for Piano and Orchestra. He also will direct the orchestra in Rabaud's symphonic poem "La Procession Nocturne" and in Beethoven's Symphony No. 3 in E Flat Major, Opus 55 ("Eroica"). During the intermission, Mr. Mitropoulos, as guest of James Fasset in the "Green Room at Carnegie Hall" feature, will describe his first experience as pianist-conductor, when he pinch-hit at the last moment for pianist Egon Petri, in his own conducting debut with the Berlin Philharmonic in 1930. He will discuss certain modern concert which can properly be played in this dual capacity. **KTSA-2:00-3:30 P.M. (FM); 10:30-12:00 P.M. (AM).**
