Broadcast Conference Recesses on New Treaty

MONTREAL, Quebec, Dec. 12. After almost three months of deliberations, during which time the general frequency allocations and broadcasting requirements affecting radio broadcasting pertinent to the Western Hemisphere formed the main topics of discussion, delegates to the Third North American Regional Broadcasting Conference have decided on a four-month recess and have tentatively set the first week of April, 1950, for reconvening.
