The Christmas spirit ruled the program in West high school auditorium, where Robert Petzold made his first appearance as the chorus' director.

And it was in the Christmas songs that the organization shone most brightly.

A jubilant singing of "Wake, Awake" started the evening, and the chorus did right well with all its first group.

But the second lacked the polish which it so sorely needed.

The Bach motet, "Be Not Afraid," was erratic—the singers seemed to lack confidence in themselves.

They recovered somewhat for Palestrina's "Hodie Christus Natus Est," at whose finish they showed their accustomed capabilities.
