Bastogne Battle

TIP O' THE MORNING: Now it can be told—Lou Landman's backstage desk lamp didn't work when the Wisconsin Union theater was darkened for his reading of the Nativity story at the University of Wisconsin Christmas festival. So he read it by the flame of a pipe-lighter.

Ten veterans of the 101st airborne division who were in the Battle of the Bulge just five years ago were in the audience which saw a special screening of "Bastogne" at the Orpheum theater Monday.

The battle began Dec. 17, 1944, when German forces drove American forces 5 miles back into Belgium and Luxembourg.

Three days later the Germans penetrated the Ardennes and opened a broad front on a road which ran through Bastogne. They isolated the Belgian village on Dec. 22, but American counter-attacks and bombings—in which 8,000 planes took part—halted them on Christmas eve.

The Germans entered Bastogne Dec. 26, and Allied forces rescued the U.S. garrison the next day.

By the end of the week, the German front was driven back.

But this was not so much the story of the battle as it was the men who were in it—a vivid picture of individuals, of American soldiers and their reaction and thoughts.

Some of the veterans said that the picture was highly authentic, even to the portrayal of the terrain and especially in its sound effects.

Anyone could see among the soldiers some people he might have known, so realistic were the characterizations from the take-it-as-it-comes attitude of James Whitmore's Kinzie to the rapid maturing of the rookie, Jim Layton, as played by Marshall Thompson.

You could list the whole cast and thus call a roll of fine players—Van Johnson, John Hodiak, Ricardo Montalban, George Murphy, an so on down the long list. Despite the advertising of "the
