Gloria De Haven, Benny Daughter, John Payne Suit to Be Reinstated

HOLLYWOOD. (CP) Movie actress Gloria De Haven, 24, has revived a divorce suit against Actor John Payne that was pending since September, 1948. Miss De Haven dropped the action in the spring after a property settlement was reached. Their reconciliation ended Oct. 28, she said yesterday when asking to reinstate the suit. Payne, 37-year-old former husband of actress Anne Shirley, and her parents of two young children waived his right to answer his wife's complaint, and the case will have an early trial. Married here Dec. 28, 1944, they had a daughter, Shirley, and a son, John, when she was 17.

'Ercil Twing' Hunts Old, Well-scuffed Briefcase

IF YOU have an old-fashioned briefcase which is so "beat up" that you'd be ashamed to carry it, there is a guy in Hollywood who would be eternally grateful to you if you'd wrap it up and mail it to him, care of Edgar Bergen, 6532 Sunset Blvd., in Hollywood. His name is Pat Patrick, but he's better known as "Professor Ercil Twing" of the Edgar Bergen-Charlie McCarthy show.

Patrick has been looking everywhere for a briefcase sufficiently dilapidated to replace the one he always carries for his radio characterization of the cantankerous professor who combs his hair down over his forehead, wears ancient specs half-way down his nose, a bicycle pants-guard half-way up his leg, and who is instantly identified to radio listeners by his familiar, high-pitched greeting: "Free-n-n-s!" "I found this one in my mother-in-law's attic," recalls Patrick, "and I used to throw it around and even scratch it with a knife to make it look more battered. Now I'm afraid it's about to fall apart completely, and I'm treating it very tenderly while I look for another one."

Patrick's array of visual gags, has made him a favorite on the night club circuit, and he crams in as many club dates as he can while touring with Bergen. "This is partly for the studio audience, and partly for me," explains Patrick. "If I didn't feel I looked the part, I'm afraid I couldn't get it into my voice, either."
