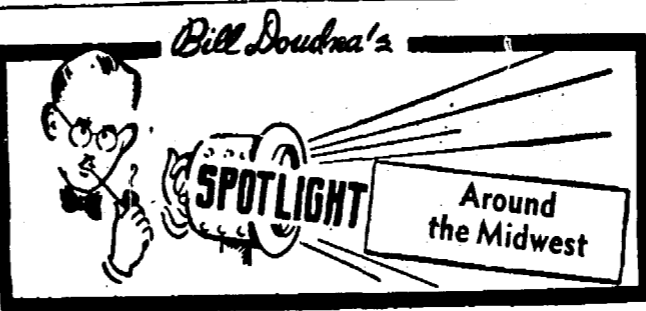

City Tax Bills Mailed; Lines Start to Form

First taxpayers' lines formed at the windows of city treasurer D. John Leigh's office Monday after tax bills were mailed out Saturday. It was impossible to determine this year who was first to pay his taxes, Leigh reported.

Most property owners received their bills Monday and all should have them by this afternoon, he said.

Leigh urged that any taxpayers who receive bills on property they formerly owned see that they are turned over to the new owner or returned to the treasurer's office with the correct information.

"Don't destroy them," he emphasized.

All new owners should report their names and property descriptions to the treasurer's office as soon as possible, he declares, so errors in addressing tax bills can be avoided next year.
