From a photostat of the Beethoven manuscript, now in Vienna, the violinist found about 80 bars which the composer had written in variance with the traditional version. Mitropoulos will lead the orchestra in the American radio premiere of Roger Sessions' Symphony No. 2, dedicated to the memory of the late Franklin D. Roosevelt, whose death occurred while Mr. Sessions was working on the slow movement. It was first performed in January 1947 by the San Fran-cisco Symphony under Monteux. 
