

Simon Becker (South) made the natural bid of one club. B. Jay Becker in the North bid two clubs. The bid of two diamonds by Simon is a reverse bid and shows an exceptionally strong hand. B. Jay did not make the mistake of bidding two no trump—he bid two hearts.
