## San Antonio Army Officer Commended for Japan Duty

Col. Richard P. Ovenshine, son of retired Brig. Gen. Alexander T. Ovenshine, of 304 Genesee Road, has been presented a certificate of achievement by the commanding general of Ninth Corps, Maj. Gen. Leland S. Hobbs. The presentation was

made recently in the corps commander's office at Sendai, Japan.

The certificate read, "For meritorious service as assistant chief of staff, G-1 Section, Headquarters Ninth Corps, Sendai, Japan, from 12 December, 1949, to 30 January, 1950. Col. Ovenshine's sound judgement, mature insight, attention to detail and soldierly qualities caused his section to render outstanding service to the units and personnel assigned to this headquarters in the planning and execution of the inactivation of the corps headquarters, and was responsible in a large part for the continued high morale during the inactivation period."

Colonel Ovenshine received his B.S. degree from the United States Military Academy in 1919 and a B.S. degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1923. During World War II he served on Saipan and Okinawa. He has been awarded the Legion of Merit and the Commendation Ribbon.

Colonel Ovenshine's wife resides at 304 Genesee Road.
