TIP OF THE MORNING: Look for drastic revisions of nighttime radio schedules next fall, with sponsors switching their radio budgets to daytime shows. Reasons: While TV is cutting into night radio, experts believe the housewife will not become a full-time TV addict for some years, sticking to radio while she works.

Richard Willoughby, Madison senior, topped the portrait division with "The Student." He is a West high school graduate, and won honorable mention in the 1948 All-City Photo salon.

Don Silver, Madison freshman, took first in still life with "Dueling Demons," a picture of two pairs of pliers. While attending West high school, he won three prizes in school salons.

Top position in color transparencies went to Felix Geiger, Madison, a graduate student in physics. His entry, "Desert Flower," was taken in New Mexico.

Lyman Conger, Jr., freshman from Kohler, won the action-photo first prize. Honorable mentions went to: Herbert Haessler, Milwaukee, in action and still life; John Mitchell, Madison, and Jesse Rabinowitz, Los Angeles, Calif., in still life; Art Andrews, Milwaukee, and Conger, in portraiture; Robert Fairman, Milwaukee, and Blyth, in the scenic class; Bill Bradley, John E. Casida, William D. Elmman, and Robert P. Homer, all of Madison, in color transparencies.
