Swift Fund Drive Set at Randolph

Randolph Air Force Base personnel are heading for a swift Red Cross campaign, scheduled for Tuesday and Wednesday only.

This is the first time that a national fund raising project for the base will be completed in two days, officials say.

The organization of the campaign is being directed mainly through the staff sections and groups of the base, and all funds collected will be turned in to the Red Cross by the appointed project officer.

Last year, the counties of Comal and Guadalupe received some \$1,300, representing the contribution of the Randolph civilian employs support of the local campaign.

Retired Workers Losing Money

A number of retired workers in San Antonio have lost several hundred dollars by failing to file claims for social security benefits, according to Gordon James, manager of the local Social Security Administration office.

He said the losses result because workers and their employers have not understood that pensions are not wages.

Accidental discovery of these cases by the social security indicates a considerable number of employers have on their payrolls workers over age 65, who are not actually rendering any services.

He advised such persons to contact him in the Federal Bldg., if they have not previously filed a claim.
