Oil Producers Want Allowable As Presently Set

San Antonio Independent Oil Producers of District No. 1, Texas Independent Petroleum and Royalty Owners' organization, voted unanimously at a recent meeting, urging that the Texas Railroad Commission establish a floor on allowables for production at present totals and agree to make no further cuts below this figure.

L. A. Douglas, vice-president of the organization, said 22 members present reached agreement on the policy for the first time, and that their resolution will be sent to the state meeting of the Texas Independent Petroleum and Royalty Owners Association at Dallas, March 9.

The oil allowable for Texas was reduced eight times during 1949 and increased once. On Feb. 24 the Texas Railroad Commission ordered a cut of 92,161 barrels daily, setting the allowable at 1,944,122 barrels a day. The figure, which applies to March, will be the lowest since last July, when the total was 1,871,938. The U.S. Bureau of Mines estimate of market demand for Texas oil in March is 2,100,000 barrels.
