Navy Aide's Plane Survives Close Call

SALT LAKE CITY — (UP) — Undersecretary of Navy Dan Kimball Friday had a close call when his transport plane brushed into a 44,000-volt power line while landing at the Salt Lake City airport. The four-motored transport carrying Kimball and a party of 12 made three approaches at the field while attempting to land about 1:30 a.m. in threatening, snowy weather.

On the final approach, field observers said, the lowered nose wheel of the big craft struck the top "common ground" cable of a four-wire transmission line one-half mile south of the field.

The cable cut the wheel and bent the four propellers, but the plane landed safely and no one was injured.

A witness said that if the plane — already flying lower than a lighted glide path — had been 3 feet lower and struck one of the main wires "it would have crashed in flames for sure."

4 State Officials to Fight Hike in Natural Gas Prices

Four state officials will go to Oklahoma Mar. 18 to fight natural gas price increases. State Public Service Commission (PSC) Chairman John Doerfer said Friday he will attend Federal Power Commission (FPC) hearings at Bartlesville, Okla., with Henry J. O'Leary, PSC rate expert; William Torkelson, PSC counsel; and Deputy Atty. Gen. Stewart Honeck.

The state is protesting the Phillips Petroleum Co.'s action in raising natural gas rates to the Michigan-Wisconsin Pipeline Co. "In effect, Wisconsin would be discriminated against," he said. "We're just starting to get natural gas and the increase would mean we'd get none of the benefits."

The pipeline company has asked the FPC's permission to offset the price increase by raising its rates. The PSC wrote the FPC the proposal was "unreasonable" because the company "should not expect to earn a full rate of return during the current initial development."

The company supplies most of the Wisconsin communities that are getting or will soon get natural gas.

Progress Reported in Airline Strike Talks
CHICAGO (UP)—Francis A. O'Neill, chairman of the National mediation board, reported Friday that "substantial progress" has been made toward settlement of the strike of American Airlines maintenance employees. Some 4,600 workers, members of the CIO Transport Workers union, have been on strike against the airlines 10 days in a wage dispute.
