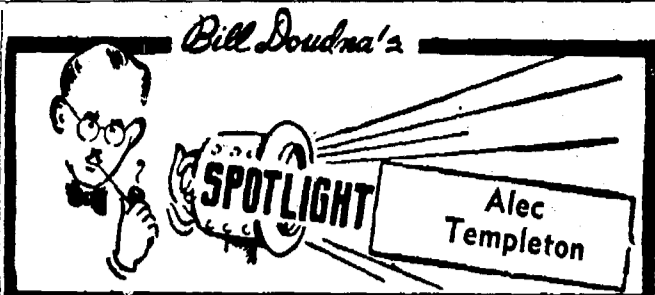

**TIP OF THE MORNING:** NBC has signed guitarist Les Paul, a Waukesha lad, and has renewed Dennis Day's contract.

Alec Templeton wowed another Madison audience Tuesday night. With his improvisations and his hilarious satires on Schoenberg, Copland, and Jolson, he had his 1,000 listeners calling for "more, more."

Those were the items most of the folks were there to hear, but before they got them, Templeton treated the audience to some expert expositions of contemporary piano music and some less expressive Bach, Beethoven, and Debussy.

His own transcription of "Sheep May Safely Graze" was in the Bach tradition, and carried considerably more authority than his "Prelude and Fugue in G Major," which opened the program, and the Beethoven "Sonata No. 3," which closed the first group.

With two Chopin preludes, things brightened considerably, and the contemporary music (notably Milhaud) sparkled.

Templeton showed a greater feeling for Bach and Beethoven in his improvisations in the style of those masters than in the earlier selections. His familiar "Bach Goes to Town" set the audience chortling, a practice which continued through a Dvorak merger with "I'll Get By," his Hawaiian suite, and the improvisations on four notes and four themes chosen by the audience.

What that man can do with music. And with "Music, Music, Music," which he united with "Rag Mop" and themes from Schubert and Rachmaninoff.

But what really brought down the house were the diabolically clever satires on a Schoenberg recital, Al Jolson singing "Evening Star," and pop artists at work covering up "Marie" like a clerk covering merchandise five minutes before closing time.

In all of these, Templeton used his versatile voice for carefree caricatures.
