

Capt, Alfred C. Hearne, 130 W. Norwood Court, a fighter pilot with the 86th Fighter-Bomber Group at Neubilberg Air Base, Germany, has been chosen as one of a team of four crack gunnery pilots to represent the group at the second annual U.S. Air Force Gunnery Meet at Las Vegas Air Base, Nevada.

Capt. Hearne was in Europe during World War II with the 79th Fighter Group. He has 1,500 hours flying time and 99 com-bat missions to his credit. He has been awarded the British Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Medal with four oak leaf clus ters and the American Defense Ribbon.


