Hearne to Attend Air Gunnery Meet
Capt. Alfred C. Hearne, 130 W. Norwood Court, a fighter pilot with the 86th Fighter-Bomber Group at Neubiberg Air Base, Germany, has been chosen as one of a team of four crack gunnery pilots to represent the group at the second annual U.S. Air Force Gunnery Meet at Las Vegas Air Base, Nevada.
Capt. Hearne was in Europe during World War II with the 78th Fighter Group. He has 1,500 hours flying time and 99 combat missions to his credit. He has been awarded the British Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Medal with four oak leaf clusters and the American Defense Ribbon.
