Delaying Play of Honors Gives Safety Insurance

HOLDING the king, queen and a small card of a suit, most players would not hesitate to play either the king or queen fourth hand, if the ace had not appeared on the trick. Those who would not have done so in today's hand are the players who study each hand carefully at the very beginning. This gives them a safety insurance that pays dividends at the end.

East won the opening lead of the jack of diamonds with the ace. South, counting his tricks, could see three or four spades, one heart, two diamonds and an undetermined number of club tricks. East returned the jack of hearts. At first this appeared a welcome lead, as it would give a declarer immediate entry to dummy for the needed club finesse. However, a little study showed him a pitfall. It would establish a finessing situation in the heart suit if the club queen was held by West—so instead of winning

LOS ANGELES, April 13. (AP) Some 2,500,000 persons now view television programs broadcast by Los Angeles stations, the Electric League of Los Angeles, Inc., announced today. League Managing Director William J. Quinn said 47,716 TV sets were sold during March, bringing the total to 496,453 or an average of one set for each 3.3 families. About 383,841 sets have been purchased since March 31, 1949, Quinn said. They represent a cash outlay of nearly \$125,000,000.
