With a com-bination like the one in the trump suit in today's hand, the automa-tic play would be to lead the suit from dummy and finesse the queen, if the king has not been played. This play sometimes gains a trick, but there are many times when it loses.

With a combination like this, one trick must be lost in the suit, because the king, lack and 10 are missing. However, if there are enough entries in the hand with the small cards, the best way to avoid losing two tricks is not to finesse, but to lay down the ace. ward the queen.
