Fiddlers' Contest

TIP O' THE MORNING: Tommy Dorsey will go to Europe in September for a 10-week tour.

Larry Borenstein, professional musician; Eddy Webb, former music instructor in the city schools, and Henry Brennan, old-time fiddler, will judge the third annual Adult Klub, which will be good for the 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. performances and for an old-time dance which will follow the evening contest.

Michael Hinn of WISC will be master of ceremonies. The dance orchestra will be composed of contestants. Prizes will be awarded for fiddlers and for novelty acts.

DE SABATA: The Italian conductor, Victor de Sabata, has been re-engaged as guest conductor of the New York Philharmonic-Symphony for next season, and will conduct two broadcasts in March, 1951.

Dimtiri Mitropoulos will be conductor of the Philharmonic-Symphony for 1950-51, with Bruno Walter, George Szell, and Leopold Stokowski as guest conductors in addition to de Sabata. France Auréli remains associate conductor.

Mitropoulos will direct the first two months of the Philharmonic's 108th season. He also will close the 28-week season, with Alban Berg's expressionistic opera, "Wozzeck," in concert form.

Dr. Walter's special four-week Brahms cycle is scheduled for broadcast from Jan. 29 through Feb. 11. Szell, on leave of absence from his own Cleveland orchestra, will be with the Philharmonic in December and January. Bernstein will conduct the orchestra for a fortnight in the spring.
