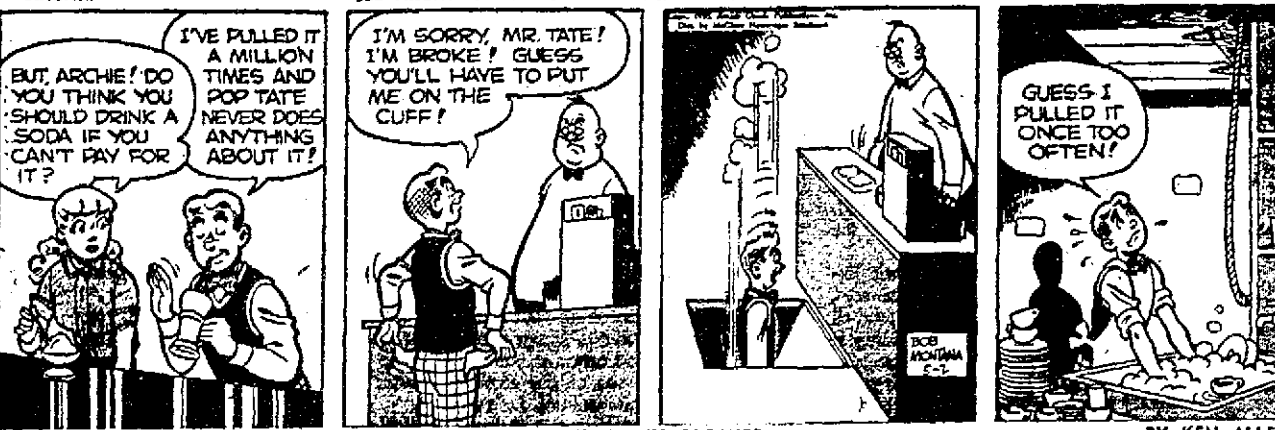

Air Force Vehicles On Sale at Kelly

Eleven hundred Air Force vehicles of 28 different types are on sale to the public through May 15 at Kelly Air Force Base.

Vehicles include fuel servicing units, 2 1/2-ton trucks, jeeps, weapon carriers, 7 1/2-ton trucks, C-2 wreckers, 25-foot float-type trailers, cranes, dollies, small trailers, warehouse tractors, sedans and "Cletracs."

The vehicles may be inspected daily, except Saturdays and Sundays, from 8 a.m. through 4 p.m., until May 15.

Bids will be accepted on individual vehicles, as well as alternate bids on lots of 2 to 25. Maj. William Conly, disposal officer at the world's largest air depot, said.

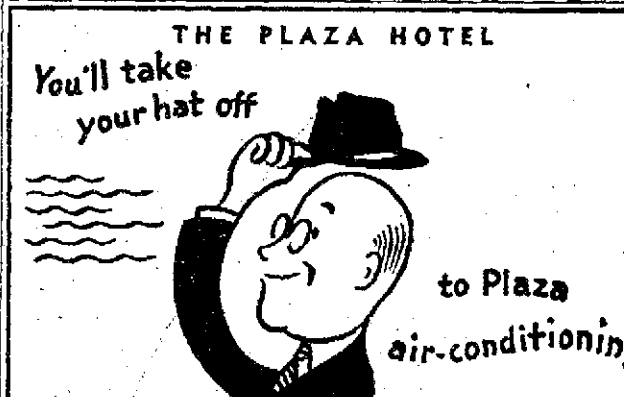

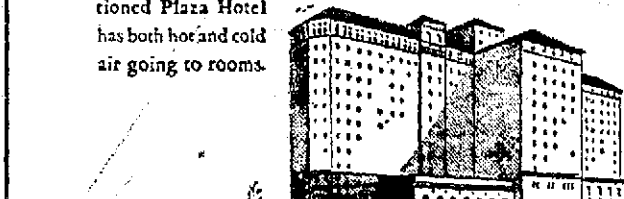
