Borden Fights Anti-Trust Suit

Tells High Court It's Too Big to Be Banned
The Borden Co. does a \$48,000,000 business in Wisconsin annually and it should not be given the same penalties as smaller companies if found guilty of violating the state anti-trust laws, the state supreme court was told Friday.

The contention was made by John R. Taylor, Chicago, counsel for the firm, as Borden and nine Milwaukee dairy companies appealed to the high court from a circuit court decision that the state had sufficient grounds to bring anti-trust action against them.

10 Firms Charged
The 10 firms are charged with engaging in an unlawful combination to restrain competition in retail and wholesale prices of milk in Milwaukee county and with fixing prices.

Taylor said that the state is asking revocation of the corporate charter of the firms, if they are found guilty, which means they will not be permitted to do business in the state.

He held that such a penalty was too severe as far as Borden was concerned since the company owned \$20,836,822 worth of property in the state and does a gross annual business of \$48,210,313.

While the revocation might not be as unjust for a small concern, it is unconstitutional and unjust causing a large concern as Borden, Taylor declared, because Borden would be penalized to a much greater extent than the other concerns.

Justice Timothy Brown pointed out that the same held true when a man with a large family and business was sentenced to jail compared with a hobo who had nothing to lose.

Leonard Hessman, chief of the anti-trust division of the attorney general's office, said it was illegal for the firms to discuss prices and then follow this up by actually setting them.

Same Law Applies
He declared that in disbarment proceedings the court doesn't consider the fact, one attorney might have a prosperous business and thus suffer greatly while another might have no business and only be affected slightly by the action.

The same law applies to rich and poor, he contended, and the size of the Borden Co. has nothing to do with revocation of its charter if it is found to have violated the law.

Dust Clouds 2 Miles Thick Darken Skies

The state's first "real" dust storm Friday afternoon clouded the sun with a layer of dust between 2 and 3 miles thick, Weatherman L. A. Joes told The State Journal Friday night.

Visibility was cut to a mile and a half and in some places, particularly near Richland Center and near Monroe, drivers were forced to stop or creep through the dust clouds with their car lights on "bright."

Joes said the dust came from the drought-stricken wheat fields of northern Kansas, swept along the path of the storm which "grew up" in the Kansas-Nebraska area.

R. J. Muckenhirn, assistant director of the Wisconsin agriculture experiment station, said the dust was the worst the state has experienced since the days of the dust bowl of the early 30's.

Farmers expressed fear of extensive erosion damage on farms where light soils predominate.

Some reported a "great" amount of topsoil was lifted off dried out fields by the gale.

On a few of the farms where windbreaks had been built erosion was definitely less noticeable, county agricultural officials said.

Joes explained that the high winds were caused by a center of extremely low atmospheric pressure which traveled through central Minnesota.

Air moved into the low pressure area at an extremely rapid rate, causing the hurricane-like winds.

The storm's pattern, Joes told The State Journal, was almost the same as that of last Oct. 10 when winds with gusts up to 70 miles an hour ripped through the city and state.

However Friday's storm, Joes said, covered a smaller area and its force was more concentrated.

Judge Reis to Preside at 'Butch' King Trial
Circuit Judge Alvin C. Reis was named Friday afternoon to preside at the first degree murder trial of George "Butch" King, which will start at 9:30 a. m., May 15.

Reis was named by Circuit Judge Arthur W. Kopp, chairman of the state board of circuit judges, to replace Circuit Judge Herman W. Sachtjen.

Sachtjen withdrew after an affidavit of prejudice against him was signed by King and filed with the court by Atty. Darrell MacIntyre.

King is in jail without bail awaiting trial on charges of the premeditated fatal shooting last July 10 of Mrs. Sadie Jackson, a Madison waitress.

State to Aid Blood Program

Time Off to Be Granted to Donors
A time grant for state employees wishing to make blood donations at the Red Cross regional blood center has been authorized by Gov. Rennebohm, according to an announcement Friday night by John E. Canfield, chairman of the blood program committee.

"I feel that this is an extremely important program and certainly if state employees are willing to donate their blood, to the cause, the state is willing to grant them one to 1 1/2 hours of time which will be required for them to make the donation," Gov. Rennebohm wrote to Canfield.

Federal Officers Aid
Canfield said that several local offices of federal civil service agencies have announced similar time grants for employees, after a recommendation by the federal personnel council of the civil service commission last September.

F. M. Davenport, chairman of the council, sent the following recommendation to council members: "The council on July 28 decided to recommend to its members the adoption by agencies of the following policy: That an employee making a donation of blood without charge be given a reasonable time off for that purpose without charge to annual or sick leave."

Continuing Need
"It is the thinking of the council, as attested by representatives of the American Red Cross and by experience with hospital blood banks, that there exists a continuing need to encourage donations of blood.

"Agency officials alone can give effect to the recommendation. We, therefore, suggest that in agencies where instructions are issued on leave matters, this point be covered, where such matters are left to administrative discretion, that publicity be given to the desirability of the practice."
