TIP OF THE MORNING: Sunday will be a busy day in Madison, with concerts, an art show, and many other events... And that may be the day chosen, too, for Madison to be the "bonus city" on "Stop the Music" via ABC-WISC... If it is the 6 p. m. show will call six city residents to identify three tunes.

Three one-act plays written, directed, and acted by University of Wisconsin students will be presented next week in the Play Circle of the Memorial Union. The plays were prize-winners in a contest conducted by Wisconsin Playwrights.

Performances will be at 8 p. m. Tuesday and at 3:30 and 8 p. m. Wednesday. "Manhattan Hermit," a comedy by Don Newell, La. Cross, will be directed by Ed Morgan, Madison. It tells of a successful playwright's return to society.

"No Carbon Paper," a fantasy by Newell, will be directed by Jo MacEachron, Burlington. Its seven scenes depict a maladjusted individual unable to adapt himself to his abnormality.

"Edi," a tragedy by Henry Clauss, Great Barrington, Mass., will be directed by Jerry McNeely, Cape Girardeau, Mo. It sketches a domestic misunderstanding with tragic consequences.

Tickets will be available to students and other Wisconsin Union members at the Union boxoffice beginning Friday noon. The event was a casualty of the windstorm, which left the prom-goers without lights and without
