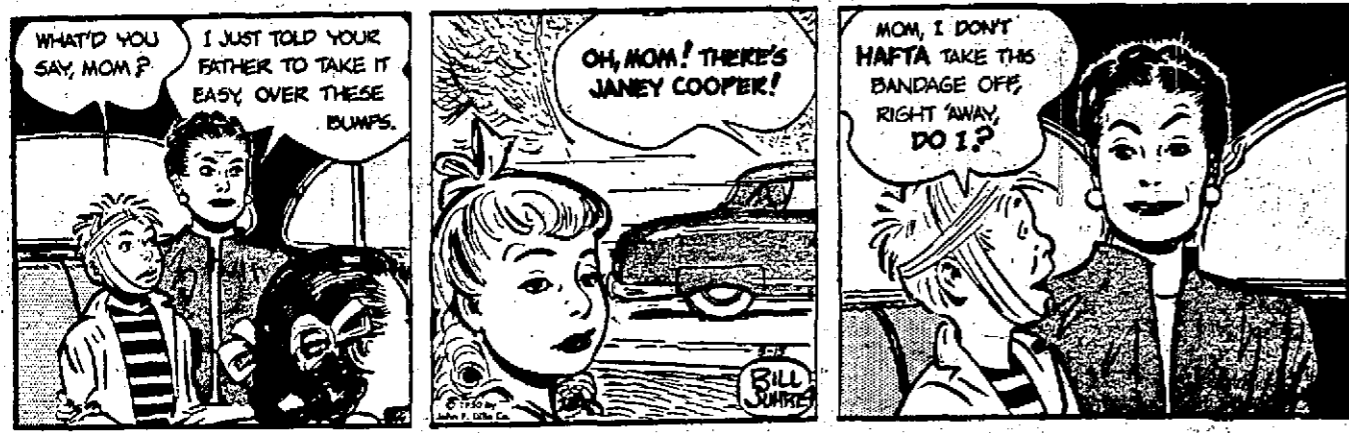

Quit Winnipeg, All Not Fighting Flood Urged
WINNIPEG—(U.P.) — All persons not actively fighting floods were urged Sunday night to flee Winnipeg and the neighboring town of St. Boniface within 48 hours before the full force of the raging Red river hits this stricken city.
In Winnipeg, pastors and army officials appealed to non-flood fighters to leave town as soon as possible. In St. Boniface, a town of 35,000 across the Red river east of Winnipeg, Mayor George McLean issued a grim Mother's Day warning.
Fear Dike Break
"We have urgently appealed to the mothers and children to leave this threatened area to protect their homes or their very lives," he said.
"We expect 8,000 to 10,000 women and children will be affected," Flood officials warned that St. Boniface would be entirely flooded in two hours if a dike breaks.
Thousands of mothers, carrying and leading their children, left St. Boniface during the day by two trains providing shuttle service over the Red river.
Rations Stockpiled
Flood officials revealed that if the Red river's new crest pushes the flood level 2 feet higher, a mass evacuation will be ordered.
Under the plan, only 75,000 persons, mostly men, would be left in the city to battle the flood waters. Emergency rations for these 75,000 persons already are being stockpiled.
City Engineer W. D. Hurst predicted, optimistically, however, that the river probably would not rise as much as one foot more.
