New Farm Workers Council to Meet

A constitution and by-laws of the newly organized Bexar County Agricultural Workers Council will be drawn up at a meeting in the Production Marketing Administration offices at the courthouse Tuesday.

Approval of the council was voted this week at a meeting of the Chamber of Commerce agricultural education committee, according to C. A. King, chairman of the committee and local P.M.A. administrative officer.

King said the organization will be made up of agricultural workers, who are on public or civic payrolls. One of the functions of the group will be to coordinate its activities, he said.

King pointed out organization of the council is one of the major objectives of the Chamber's agriculture education committee.
