'Larceny' Play Study Will Reward Student of Bridge

"You'd never get away with that play against an expert," snarled West when today's hand was played. Larceny Lou smiled and quietly answered, "I wasn't playing against an expert. Besides, I did get away with it, didn't I?"

Actually, Lou's play would probably succeed against most players. It is a type that comes up fairly often and therefore will reward careful study.

West opened the five of diamonds, East played the jack, and Lou won with the queen. Lou could count four club tricks, two hearts, and two diamonds. The only suit in which he could produce the ninth trick was spades.

For this purpose, Lou led a club to dummy at the second trick. He then returned the six of spades from dummy. If East had been an expert he would have held the ace of spades.

He could then return a diamond, knocking out South's ace. West would still have the ace of spades.

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On the Air Waves

Domination of Color TV Sought, Says S. F. Man

SAN FRANCISCO, May 19. (AP) The Federal Communications Commission studied charges today that the giants of the radio industry are trying to dominate television through control of color rights.

The charges were made by Arthur S. Matthews, president of Color Television, Inc., of San Francisco, against Radio Corporation of America and Columbia Broadcasting System. Matthews' company is seeking FCC approval for its color television system.

In a statement issued after commissioners viewed the CTI system, Matthews claimed the CTI system was compatible with present receivers, produced a good color picture and required no "soup-up" of transmitters.

Matthews said he had received word from Mexico City that his television system has been granted and he will start construction as soon as he completes formation of an operating company.

He said he has also been granted a power increase for station XEAC from its present 5000 watts to 50,000, making it one of the most powerful stations on the coast.
