Bank Auditors Elect W. D. Young

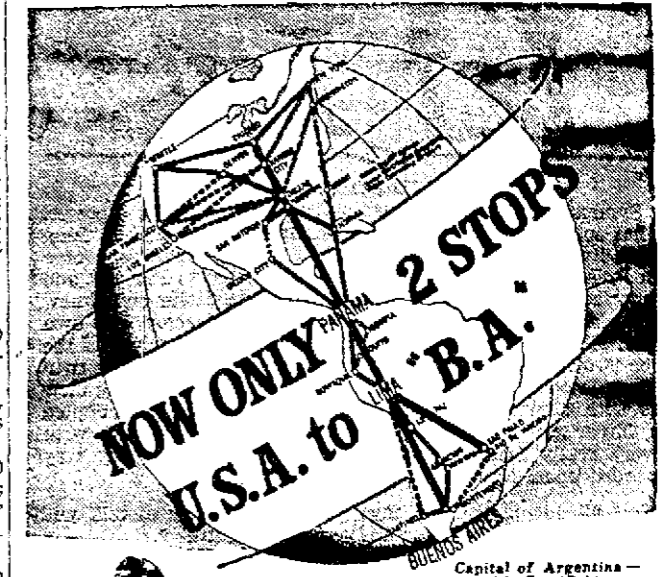
