CO-OPERATION URGED

Health Director Sounds Fly Control Warnings

Fly control warnings were sounded by Dr. Austin E. Hill, public health director, who said with the coming of warm, moist weather, fly control becomes increasingly important in San Antonio.

"This is a matter that cannot be handled by any city agency alone, because it requires the assistance and cooperation of every resident," he said.

The only effective method of fly control is the elimination of places where the adult flies lay their eggs and which furnish feeding places for the developing maggots, Dr. Hill explained. Flies' habits are filthy, and as a result, anything upon which the flies lie may become dangerously contaminated with disease germs and result in sickness being transmitted to the next individual who touches the contaminated object.

"It is possible for one pair of flies in the early spring, to start a series of descendants, which, if they all lived until the end of the breeding season in the fall, would occupy enough space to cover the whole earth including the polar regions and the oceans to a depth of 47 feet," Dr. Hill stated.

For this reason, Dr. Hill continued, it is obvious that control of the breeding areas is the only possible successful means

of combating the filthy creatures. It is a problem which concerns every citizen everywhere. "In so much that it becomes a crime, even under our state laws, for any person to allow fly breeding to take place within his knowledge, laws and ordinances unsupported by Mr. Average Citizen have no beneficial effects in the modern democratic society.

"It necessarily becomes the duty of each one to assist in the elimination of the source of flies in San Antonio," he said.
